<u>Limits</u>

- Economic resources from Eu
- Limited local budged & financial supports
- Limited local infrastructures

- Shortage of personnel
- Volunteering assistance and organisational staff
- Professional long-term monitoring for follow-up activities success
- Youth commitment and enthusiams that decreases
- Cooperations between municipality and citizens (shared obligations and trust)

Follow-up activities for project's diffusion

(Different forms of civic community engagement for young people):

- Maintaining a community garden, local clean-ups.
- Contribuiting to requalification of local properties.
- Contribuiting to design places for hang out in the neighbourhood.
- Participating in a local blood drive.
- Helping set up a local farmer market.



Vänersborg Project proposals

These ideas for follow-up activities are the expression of a collective will to produce social value for the benefit of the whole community

"The Vänersborg youth chart"

is a cooperation pact, (a collaboration agreement) thanks to which active citizens can identify activities to improve the urban local development.

• "Artistic call" - "Manifesto for the future" -new perspective through art and culture.

Through art (graphic, painting, sculptures, artistic creations) youngsters can express & shape their ideas of future in Vänersborg. it can be created an artistic occasion for youngsters as builders of their own knowledge.



Work Integrated Learning Perspective

- Work Integrated Learning (WIL), is "about learning through a lively exchange of ideas, reflection and active participation" (UniversityWest, 2022)
 - Knowledge is created in many parts of society not only within academia.
 - This exchanging-knowledge project is a positive <u>Learning by doing experience</u> where participants have experienced a constructive growth & chance to learn the <u>significance of reflection and its impact on attitudes and skills</u>. This way of education is useful model for future generation of knowledge.
 - It can support the development of educational methods positive for the entire community.

Conclusions & results

The project has produced:

- More awareness among participants.
- Creation of youth influencers that promote democratic and mental wellbeing through cultural activities.
- Increased understanding of democratic discussions.
- Increased international networking between cultural centres & libraries.
- Good practices of inclusion and wellbeing with new knowledge & reflection.

A positive learning experiences with new competences for long-life learning






